

About the long section from letter $\, {f B} \,$ to letter $\, {f F} \,$:

- The pianist decides the tempo variations of this section.
- The signs $\downarrow \approx 60$, poco meno mosso, meno mosso and piu mosso are indicative.
- The pianist is encouraged to continously explore different tempi. Consider the numerous *accel.*'s and *rit.*'s to be elastic matter.
- All the performers should in an <u>interactive</u> way make variations upon the notated dynamics which are open ended (except for the start dynamic of *mezzo piano*). The range from *pianissimo* to a solid *forte* should be included, characterized by slow or medium slow transformations through the different *cresc*. and *decresc*.
